

Endorsement:

The mother brings this urgent motion pursuant to the Consolidated Notice to the Public and the Profession issued by the Chief Justice on May 19, 2020 together with the Notice for South West Region during the suspension of Court operations due to COVID-19.

Based on her submissions I find the motion to be presumptively urgent . The mother is seeking an order for a parenting plan and relater terms, an order that the father carry the costs of the matrimonial home and a restraining order, these being the only issues that are urgent for the purposes of this motion.

I order as follows:

1. The motion shall be heard by Zoom conference at a hearing to be scheduled by the trial coordinator on Thursday, August 6, 2020, who shall provide call in details in due course.
2. The mother shall forthwith issue an application from the court.
3. The mother shall serve the father by email a copy of her issued application, notice of motion, supporting affidavit and a copy of this endorsement and file the material with proof of service by email to the trial coordinator and courthouse by 4:30 pm, Friday, July 24, 2020.
4. The father shall serve the mother his response by email and file same with proof of service with the trial coordinator and courthouse by email by no later than 4:30 pm, Friday, July 31, 2020.
5. The mother shall serve and file a short reply affidavit if required in the same manner by no later than 4:30 pm, Tuesday, August 4, 2020.
6. Subject to the discretion of the hearing judge, no affidavit shall exceed 10 pages in length not including exhibits, the exhibits shall include only those relevant to the urgent motion and shall not exceed 10 pages in length and there shall be no third party affidavits. Reference to case law shall be by hyperlink. Affidavits may be served and filed unsworn but will be affirmed at the beginning of the hearing.
