Present for the Motion were Mr. Vallillee representing the Applicant mother, who was not present, Mr. Brandon Doxtator the Respondent father and his counsel, Ms. Erica Doxtator. The matter was heard by Zoom on consent of all parties.

A Motion was filed by the Applicant mother on July 22, 2020 seeking to change the Temporary Order of Justice Henderson which was made on March 10, 2020. This motion was triaged by Justice Henderson and deemed to be "urgent" pursuant to the *Consolidated Notice to the Profession, Litigants, Accused Persons, Public and the Media, effective May 19, 2020*. I agree that this is an urgent matter relating to access to the child, Melolee Laura Ann Simmons born August 22, 2019.

Also before the Court was a Motion by the Respondent father seeking to change the Temporary order of March 10, 2020 as it relates to access and seeking leave to bring an urgent motion for interim custody of the child, Melolee Laura Ann Simmons born Aug. 22, 2019.

The motion filed by the Respondent was not "triaged" in accordance with the *Consolidated Notice* to determine whether it could proceed on an urgent basis and accordingly was not heard today. The Respondent can make the appropriate request to have the matter heard on an urgent basis in accordance with the *Consolidated Notice to the Profession, Litigants, Accused Persons, Public and the Media, effective May 19, 2020*.

Upon review of the Affidavits filed and hearing submissions, I make the following orders on an Interim basis: I order that paragraph 2 of the Order of Henderson J. dated March 10, 2020 shall be terminated.

It is further ordered that the Respondent, Brandon Lee Doxtator shall have access and contact with the child, Melolee Laura Ann Simmons, born August 22, 2019 for two hours every other weekend at Merrymount Family Support and Crisis Centre commencing once Merrymount reopens and makes its services available following its closure due to the Covid-19 pandemic;

It is further ordered that commencing immediately, and for as long as the services of Merrymount Family Support and Crisis Centre remain unavailable to the parties due to Covid-19, the Respondent shall have video access and contact with the child every Saturday at 1:00pm for at least 15 minutes, and at least on one other day during the week, for a period of 15 minutes or at such other time as the parties mutually agree to in advance through counsel.

Since Merrymount Family Support and Crisis Centre remains unavailable at this time, It is further ordered that the Respondent, Brandon Lee Doxtator shall have supervised access time with the child for a period of at least 2 hours, 2 days per week on a schedule to be determined by counsel ONLY if it supervised by a responsible, mutually agreed upon third party. Such supervisor to be mutually agreed upon in advance through counsel.
