The wife brings this urgent motion pursuant to the Consolidated Notice to the Public and the Profession issued by the Chief Justice on May 19, 2020 together with the Notice for South West Region during the suspension of Court operations due to COVID-19.

Based on her submissions I find the motion to be presumptively urgent. The husband has not complied with the order for payment for the home.

I order as follows:

1. The motion shall be heard by Zoom conference at a hearing to be scheduled by the trial coordinator for Wednesday, September 16, 2020 who shall provide call in details in due course.
2. The wife shall serve the husband a copy of her notice of motion, supporting affidavit and this endorsement by email and file the material with proof of service to the trial coordinator and courthouse by 4:30 pm Wednesday, August 26, 2020.
3. The husband shall serve the wife his response by email and file same with proof of service with the trial coordinator and courthouse by email by no later than 4:30 pm on Wednesday, September 2, 2020.

4. The wife may serve and file a short reply affidavit if required in the same manner by no later than 4:30 pm on Wednesday, September 9, 2020.
5. Subject to the discretion of the hearing judge, no affidavit shall exceed 10 pages in length not including exhibits, the exhibits shall include only those relevant to the urgent motion and shall not exceed 10 pages in length and there shall be no third party affidavits. Reference to case law shall be by hyperlink. Affidavits may be served and filed unsworn but will be affirmed at the beginning of the hearing.
