Subject: RE: Urgent Motion: 842/20 - Nabhan v Tahhan

The father brings this urgent motion pursuant to the Consolidated Notice to the Public and the Profession issued by the Chief Justice on May 19, 2020 during the suspension of Court operations due to COVID-19.

Based on his submissions I find the motion to be presumptively urgent. The father is seeking an order for the return to Ontario of the three youngest children. Proceedings have been commenced by the Applicant

in this Court and without prior notice she removed the children to New Brunswick in October.

I order as follows:

1. The motion shall be heard by Zoom conference at a hearing to be scheduled by the trial coordinator on Monday, January 11, 2021, who shall provide call in details in due course.
2. The father shall serve the mother by email a copy of his notice of motion, supporting affidavit and a copy of this endorsement and file the material with proof of service by email to the courthouse through the family portal at <http://www.ontario.ca/familyclaims> by 4:30 pm, Friday, December 18, 2020.
3. The mother shall serve her response by email and file same with proof of service with the courthouse at the same address by email by no later than 4:30 pm, Wednesday, January 6, 2021.
4. The father shall serve and file a short reply affidavit if required in the same manner by no later than 4:30 pm, Thursday, January 7, 2021.
5. Subject to the discretion of the hearing judge, no affidavit shall exceed 10 pages in length not including exhibits, the exhibits shall include only those relevant to the urgent motion and shall not exceed 10 pages in length and there shall be no third party affidavits. Reference to case law shall be by hyperlink. Affidavits may be served and filed unsworn but will be affirmed at the beginning of the hearing.
