Notes:

1. Trials will be conducted in the courtroom currently assigned to the Family Court (#19).
2. All of the above events will be virtual, either by Zoom or teleconference. R39 and Summary Hearings will be group conferences. The R39 clerk will be available starting at 9:00 for adjournments, with court opening at 9:30. Summary Hearings will be limited to 4 per Friday afternoon.
3. Accommodation will be made for the morning break.
4. No hand- ins of documents will be permitted the day of the hearing. All documentation is to be filed through the Family Submissions Online portal (Justice Services Online).
5. It is anticipated long motions will be scheduled starting in the New Year Friday mornings at 10:00 and 11:30 replacing the conferences.
6. The backlog of cases (March 17-June 30) will be given priority with no new work being accepted until it is addressed. Trials will be adjourned to speak to date(s) late winter/early spring. Again, priority will be given to backlog trials.
7. "Urgent motions" will likely be scheduled for the time being subject to the availability of judges.
8. At this time, it is expected the DRO's will recommence the end of September. In the meantime, judges will continue sitting on the case conferences arising from motions to change.
