

SCHEDULE CHANGES

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 17, 2022

In order to address the case conference backlog, the following changes are being made to the schedule of the CAS weekly list commencing the week of January 17, 2022:

1. The four CAS days previously dedicated to “speak to” days are being condensed into two, Monday and Thursday. Friday will remain dedicated to CAS motions.
2. Commencing January 19, 2022, case conferences will be held on every other Tuesday and every Wednesday. On the alternate Tuesday, urgent motions will be heard.
3. In order to request an urgent motion, motion material that complies with the Direction to the Profession of the Chief Justice dated September 11, 2021 is to be sent to assistant trial coordinator Chris Marquis at Chris.Marquis@ontario.ca with a c.c to trial coordinator Doris Hagarty at doris.hagarty@ontario.ca. The material will then be triaged by a judge and Mr. Marquis will forward a time and date if approved by the judge. If a litigant is in court and a request for an urgent motion is approved by the judge, the judge may obtain a date from the trial coordinator.
4. On each Wednesday at 9:30, three Early Case Conferences will be heard in the one hour timeslot. The procedure with respect to those conferences is set out in a separate Practice Direction which accompanies this memorandum.
5. In order to address the immediate case conference timeout issue, a blitz is being scheduled for the weeks of January 24 and 31, 2022. All currently scheduled from March 1, 2022 case conferences are to be brought forward at the request of the litigants.
